Best Practice No -1

1) **Title of the Practice :** Nehru College Women's Hostel Hubli established as Anjuman Covid-19 Care Centre

2) **Objective of the practice**

During the second wave of covid-19 pandemic many people rich and poor of all ages, cast and Creed were helplessly moving from pillar to pillar, hospital to hospital in search of a better medical facilities and vacant bed for their near and dear ones. It was a herculean task to spent huge amount of money but still only few lucky ones survived majority of the people died mainly because of non-availability of beds & proper medicine and even private clinics /hospitals were not open.

The entire above problem made our management and the staff to do something to reduce the suffering of the people. At this hour finally it was decided to hand over the Nehru College Women's Hostel to the District Administration, Dharwad for establishing the Covid care centre and treat the people. District Administrative Office agreed to work with complete team of doctors for 24/7 so that people of the area and nearby villages get timely proper treatment

3) **The Context**

The staff and management held a meeting to think about its hostel to hand over to the district administrative office to establish Covid care centre. As our women's hostel was vacated during lockdown and it was ideal. This made our staff and Management to think why it should not be used for a good cause. so we made correspondence with district administrative office Dharwad. They too agreed and it was inaugurated on 23rd August 2020 at 5:00 pm by the Hon'ble former Chief Minister of Karnataka and dist in-charge Minister Shri Jagadish Shetter and Hubli City MLA (constituency 72) Shri Prasad Abhaya. Smt Kusumavati Shivalli (MLA Kudgol) and DC shri Nitish Patil, The area corporators, the representatives of Hubli Dharwad Municipal Corporation health department and others were present. Then district administrator carried out their work and formed a dedicated and highly qualified medical team which work 24/7 meticulously. The team gave a good service to the patients and the patients from different areas of Dharwad district were admitted and treated. It was a 100 bed centre with all facilities such as separate rooms for ladies, gents and aged persons etc.

4) **The practice**

Covid- 19 pandemic created such a fear in the heart and mind of public that they even got frightened to burying their dead ones. People thought that it is better to be a patient is the parent or child of their own. During such difficult time when our management and staff decided to hand over the college women's hostel to convert into Covid care centre

5) Evidences of success

Nehru College women's hostel which was converted into 100 bed Covid care centre. The many sponsors came forward to help, 100 cats and beds were sponsored by Azad Urban Co-operative Bank Hubli, Our management carried out repair work of approach Road and cleaning of the hostel and its surrounding area. Then district administrative office with medical team visited and converted the hostel into Covid care centre. The patients were brought from all corners of Dharwad district to the centre. The centre now became hectic spot which worked 24/7 meticulously giving the treatment to the patients. The district administrative officers took rounds daily and supplied food & medicines from time to time, and gave moral support to the patients to developed a good rapper with district administrative officers and good friendly atmosphere was created in the centre by the all patients. Their difficulties personal issues related to post Covid periods was separately addressed by the senior doctors, how to face the difficulties and how to deal with the post Covid health issues, whom to approach and what should be the diet & exercise etc

This brave step of Management was a positive step which made other schools and colleges to extend all support & come forward to hand over their infrastructure to the district administrative office Dharwad. Two prestigious Lodges of Hubli City were given accommodation to the doctors after duty hours for rest & to stay in the lodge instead of going to home and putting the family members and neighbours at risk. The food, laundry, recreation TV Wi-Fi was provided. It was the collective team work.



6) Problems encountered and resources required


Initially when the management and the staff discussed about handing over the vacated women's hostel to district administrative office to convert into Covid care centre with an objective to reduce the pains of the people/society, the people who are residing around the hostel were not agreeing because they had a fear about the Covid spreading very fast, non availability of beds and in case if they are infected high medical expenses. Then management created awareness by announcement & visit to this area. Dr. Maqsood Jahagirdar volunteer with the Anjuman Islam created public awareness. Later Dr. Maqsood Jahagirdar died due to covid-19. He was a alumnus of this college.

The people of all walks of life irrespective of caste and creed came forward to help the other maybe in the form of food Finance moral support to the patients to move in and out when the public was aware and Saw people coming to help the needy distributed free hygienic food to the patients in spite of the Dharwad district administrative office doing all the services.

Each one trying their best to reduce the pain of the people and what best they can contribute to the society at the need of an hour, as everyone was feeling the pain of the other this made to come forward with whatever resources they had to help. If this kind of helping is continued we feel that nobody will be hunger and no one will die due to lack of medical care and resources can be generated amongst the people they may not depend government to come and


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help at that hour all the problems that we face were solved by creating awareness giving helping hand to the needy

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Best Practice No -2

1) Title of the practice: :Terrarium Training Programme Under Earn and Learn

Introduction: In the modern world where there is dearth of land and space for the habitation of the growing population, Nature and world together struggle stand up to the needs of man. In such scenario, we have come up with a healthy practice of creating Terrarium. Nuclear families, nuclear homes, less time and less space should not be an obstacle to a healthy life. In this race of prosperity and fitness, we have tried to in-built a Terrarium Training Programme under earning and learning scheme.

2) Objectives:

Terrarium is a Latin word. It stands for terra-earth and arium-a place, Hence it comprises of basically earth in a particular place. Closely linked to earth, place and water

Terrarium is one of the vivarium in which the plant of interest or plant of our choice is grown in the ecosystem. A special feature of this terrarium is that it can be placed anywhere at home or at the office space. The plant needs a congenial atmosphere of air, sunlight, carbon dioxide, water but least care for its growth.

Terrarium creates calming atmosphere and is an added decorative piece of work at any and every place. It is a perfect plan as it requires less maintenance and is easy to carry from place to place. Terrarium plants emit oxygen into the air which means that terrarium has multiple health benefits. The main objective of growing plant in a terrarium is to observe how ecosystem sustains itself in an enclosed atmosphere.

Individually the students are involved in developing their skills related to soil profile, ecosystem management and sustenance. Students learn and gain the valuable knowledge about the terrarium. Under this earn and learn scheme terrarium training programme they also learn to construct their own terrarium which ultimately provides self-employment to them. In this programme the students made to understand the basic concepts of life science such as, Importance of light, Soil profile, watering, ecosystem, sustenance of environmental factors, types of forest and plant associations.

3) The Context:

It was a challenging task to design and implement the aforesaid programme. At the initial stage, a meeting was conducted with the advisory committee. The MoU was signed and the systematic study of the same was outlined by BoS (Board of studies) was formed to design the curriculum of this training programme, which was supposed to last for ten days. After the compilation of the syllabus, it was successfully implemented.

Challenges and issues faced:

1. The challenge and issues faced by the advisory committee and the BOS was that it was an entirely new concept. There was not original trace or track to pursue. Initiative was taken, but the details and the constructive planning of the same had to be explored, discovered and implemented.
2. Another challenge faced by us was that the concept was new before us, but the sources materials, and availability of the designed syllabus was out of our reach.
3. Third challenge was how to procure the glass wares to construct the Terrarium

4. Implementation of the above training was a vast challenge faced by us. Due to Covid-19 and the lockdown period, the online demonstration and training to be given to students was herculean task.

The challenges faced by us were easily met by coming to a mutual outcome which was workable.

A. The first challenge of the new concept was solved by including the intellectual well-versed staff in this particular well designed syllabus.

B. The second challenge of the dearth of the material on this concept was solved by downloading e-books and the notes were prepared for the same.

C. The third challenge was solved by one of our Alumni Shri. Abdul Khadar Makandar who is an entrepreneur in Aquarium business

D. The fourth challenge was met by demonstrating step by step and explaining to the students online to do the same. Students were co-operative and assimilated the demonstration and practice it later.

4) The Practice:

The practice was commenced by designing the syllabus. This syllabus had to be covered in 30 hours. It includes four units (18 hours) and four practicals (12 hours). The duration of the course was 10 days. The time table was framed to conduct the online classes by the skilled faculty. The online classes were conducted through the zoom app. The timing for the same on working days was from 3.00 pm to 6.00 pm.

The framed syllabus was as follows:

Unit 1: Terrarium: History-definition -Types - Based on type of container (Open and closed system terrarium) -Based on plant type (Desert, Rainforest, and Carnivorous Terrariums)

Unit 2: Requirements for terrarium: Containers - small stones or pebbles- activated charcoal -potting soil - moss -fertilizers - decorations - plants (suitable for open system and closed system terrariums).

Unit 3: Steps involved in making terrarium – (Demonstration will be shown in practicals).

Unit 4: Maintenance of terrarium: Light requirement–Watering –Humidity- Fertilizing- Ventilation and Temperature –Threats for terrarium (from insect, pests and moulds) – Economic importance - Terrarium Marketing.

In this course, about one hundred and fifty students from different colleges registered and benefited from the same. The programme was organized under the title Earn and Learn in collaboration with KLE's S.K. Arts and H.S.K Science institute, Hubballi (MoU was signed with them). Students from Government First Grade College Rajnagar Hubballi, from Global Innovative College, Hubballi, from MES College, Bengaluru also registered for this course. The entire course was conducted through online mode.

On the occasion of the Tropical Rainforest Day, i.e. on 22nd June the program was held Major. Dr. M. F. Ansari Retired Principal, Nehru Degree College Hubballi, inaugurated the programme and spoke on the occasion.

The following features were highlighted in the various sessions conducted during the course.

Based on the containers used, the terrarium is open system terrarium (if open container is used) and closed system terrarium (if closed container is used), Based on the types of plant used the terrariums are classified into Desert, Rainforest and Carnivores Terrariums.

The requirement for creating the terrarium is that the glass containers of different shapes and size should be used, and glass containers are used because they do not have any side effect on plants. Besides, these containers should be such wherein light can penetrate easily.

Containers used for terrarium should be optimally made from glass. As glass is clear and tend to maintain a consistent temperature .If cloudy and tinted glass is used then it reduces the amount of light which the plant receives.

Applicable rules and regulations have been followed while selecting the suitable and optimal containers for the terrarium. .Terrarium do not have mean of draining water, to combat this issues, a layer of rock, pebbles, or sand should be placed at the bottom of the terrarium and sufficient space should be provided for the excess water to be drained off. Activated charcoal (its key function is filtration and has the ability to bind toxins, microbes and all sorts of other undesirable things), fertilizers, potting mixture and decorative items can be used and plants suitable for open and closed system terrariums are studied.

Alumnus of our college, Abdul Khadar Makandar (who is an entrepreneur in Aquarium business) demonstrated how to make the glass containers of different shape and size .The construction of the terrarium, includes different steps like adding a layer of stones, upon which a layer of charcoal and few centimeter thick layer of potting soil was added. After setting the layers of the soil in this manner, then the plants was planted

The maintenance of the terrarium was also highlighted. Different factors like light requirement, for open and closed system terrarium, the watering requirement varies with the type of the plant used in the terrarium. All these factors like, light, watering, humidity, ventilation were discussed in the concern with the terrarium

The valedictory programme was done on 2nd July 2021 and we had Dr. Uma V. Nerle Principal of KLE's S.K. Arts and H.S.K. Science Institute Hubballi as a chief guest for the programme.

Limitations:

Due to Covid-19 pandemic, hands on practice was not done. And the demonstration for making the terrarium was done through online mode.

5) Evidence of Success:

Terrarium training was imparted to the students. It inculcated the following features and benefits to the students.

1. It created awareness among the students about the terrarium environment. Their knowledge increased and it proved to be a learning experience for them.
2. The students realized the significance and value of plant life in the world. They became more accountable to the environment and felt that they have an obligation to maintain a healthy and pure atmosphere.
3. Students learnt about the interaction between biotic and abiotic component of ecosystem.

4. With this activity students are made to understand the biogeochemical cycles like carbon cycle, nitrogen cycle and also learnt about water cycle.
5. Students learnt about the essential components required for the terrarium. Besides, they learnt to work for the same with the scientific methods/process. They felt updated with the latest knowledge of the plant kingdom.
6. Terrarium Training imparted the knowledge of scientific physiological process like photosynthesis and respiration.
7. This activity made the students independent and self-employed. They had an inkling that they could take up terrarium as a profession which would take them, in the long run, on to the path of success. They can pick it up and market it and establish themselves in the field of health and wealth simultaneously.
8. Unit Test was conducted for the participants who were trained and certificates of participation were issued online


6) Problems encountered and Resources required:

As this course was conducted online, due to Covid-19 pandemic, we faced many problems in carrying out the terrarium training.

The first problem faced was of ineffective time management .Due to network issues some students could not be reached effectively within the limited time duration and the facts and concepts explained could not be imbibed by the students'. Though effective teaching and demonstration was carried out but the receivers were helpless due to network problems and they missed out certain concepts.

As the concept was new, the sources, raw materials were not easily available .Consequently, because of the new concept ,marketing for the same was not an easy task .People had to be made aware that what is terrarium and how they could be benefitted from it.

The ground was not ripe for marketing .The seeds were sown but the taste of the fruit had to be visualized. The idea had to be brought to the home which would develop with time
