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Anjuman-e-Islam, Hubli, is a premier central organization of Muslims in Hubli City, established in 1903 with the vision "Service to Humanity." The Anjuman-e-Islam, Hubli, started Nehru Pre-University Arts, Science, Commerce College and Nehru Arts, Science Degree College in 1965 to perpetuate the humanism of Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru after his death in 1964. Later on, we added Commerce faculty in 1973, BBA in 1997, BCA in 2007, M.A. Economics in 1999, and M.A. English and M.Com. during the academic year 2011–12. From 2020–21, our college is selected as the learners support centre of Karnataka State Open University (KSOU) Muktagangotri, Mysuru, which offers different courses for both UG and PG, including MBA and other professional courses. Since 1999, we have been running the Institute of Information Technology, which caters to free computer training for students and is sponsored by the National Council for Promotion of Urdu Language (NCPUL), Delhi, and Govt. of India.

The college is accredited and reaccredited with an 'A' grade consecutively in 3 cycles by NAAC. With 18 doctoral degree holders, 3 M.Phil holders, and 3 D.Litt. holders on the teaching staff, the college has rich resources for imparting quality education. They have also been guiding PhD and M.Phil aspirants. They also extend their services to act as external referees for other universities. Syed Feroze Ahamed has registered for a Ph.D. at Maharaja Agrasena Himalayan Garhwal University, Uttarakhand. One of our colleague's students, Tajjunissa Mahmood, has been awarded a doctoral degree in history. The NSS unit of our college held an annual camp for NSS volunteers at Kuruvinakoppa, Kalghatgi Taluka, Dharwad District,

from June 18 to June 24, 2023, as part of our institutional social responsibility to foster civic values and the importance of sustainable development.

About fifty students took part. Sameena Banu Girni won a gold award from Karnatak University in Urdu for our college. This academic year, progress has improved; 23 studies have been submitted for PG.
